





Previous Experience of 2009-10 Fellows




2010-11 Discipline Categories

Yearlong Fellows (n=210)




Years Since Qualifying Degree


All Yearlong Fellows (n=210)

Where do Fellows go after their fellowship?

- » *Renew their fellowship*
- » *Get hired by their agency or office*
- » *Work for another federal agency*
- » *Work for a professional society, think tank, nonprofit government relations, etc.*

- » *Return to previous position (sabbatical)*

- » *Move into a position in a new sector*
- » *Start a new academic degree program*
